REQUEST

I would also like to understand what training staff receive in working with and supporting care leaver patients with Autism and ADHD. Specifically:

- 1. What training is provided on Autism and ADHD awareness and support?
- 2. Is there specific training on working with care leavers who have these conditions?
- 3. How are staff equipped to provide appropriate adjustments and person-centred care?

RESPONSE

1. What training is provided on Autism and ADHD awareness and support?

All staff complete mandatory training in Learning Disability and Autism awareness training. There is no specific training in relation to awareness of ADHD.

2. Is there specific training on working with care leavers who have these conditions?

No, however in addition to the training referred to in section1, all staff receive Mandatory Safeguarding Training which includes support for children in care.

3. How are staff equipped to provide appropriate adjustments and person-centred care?

Yes there are various policies and processes in place which support the staff to recognise the need for and implement reasonable adjustments including:

- Use of electronic flags on patient records.
- Health passports
- Easy Read information available in different languages
- Use of interpreters
- Flexibility in appointments
- Additional support from carers / family members when accessing services
- Support from specialist Learning Disability / Autism nurses
