Can you please provide a breakdown of how much was spent per grade of doctor, specialty of doctor and the number of doctors successfully deployed.
- 4. Can you please name which agencies provided the work/doctors outlined in question 3 and how many doctors each one has successfully provided to the Trust?
- 5. Has the Trust conducted any overseas trips since 2022 to conduct recruitment activities for doctors?
