RESPONSE

ICB stands for Integrated Care Board, which is a part of the NHS in England. It replaced Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) in July 2022 and is responsible for planning and funding healthcare services in a specific region.

Due to its geographical footprint Mersey and West Lancashire Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust falls under both NHS Cheshire and Merseyside Integrated Care Board (ICB) and South Cumbria Integrated Care Board (ICB).

The ICB is responsible for overseeing healthcare services and funding in the region, ensuring coordination between hospitals, community services, and other healthcare providers. Mersey and West Lancashire Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust are responsible for delivering the health care services commissioned by the ICB.

The Chief Executive Officer of Mersey and West Lancashire Teaching Hospital NHS Trust is an employee of the Trust, so the Trust pays their salary.
