REQUEST

Incidents of naloxone shortages triggered by treating overdoses of potent synthetic opioids over the last five years

I would like to know the number of instances at this NHS Trust between May 2020 and May 2025, where treating a patient who has overdosed on a potent synthetic opioid has involved the hospital having to use its entire supply of naloxone.

- 1. Date of the incident
- 2. Age and gender of the patient
- 3. Type of synthetic opioid which led to the overdose (if known)
- 4. Volume of naloxone required to treat the patient
- 5. Impact on the hospital's stock of naloxone (e.g. how much was used)
- 6. Action taken by the hospital as a result (e.g. was a shortage officially declared?)
