REQUEST

Request 1:

The total revenue generated from car parking fees to *staff* for every hospital within your NHS Trust during the financial year 2024/25.

Request 2:

The total revenue generated from car parking fees to *visitors* for every hospital within your NHS Trust during the financial year 2024/25.

Request 3:

The number of parking fines (or PCNs) issued to *staff* using car parks at every hospital within your NHS Trust and the total revenue generated from those PCNs during the financial year 2024/25.

Request 4:

The number of parking fines (or PCNs) issued to *visitors* using car parks at every hospital within your NHS Trust and the total revenue generated from those PCNs during the financial year 2024/25.

RESPONSE

Request 1:

For the financial year 2024/25, income from staff car parking charges was £1,189,936.

The income generated from car parking contributes towards the cost of providing and maintaining car parking facilities and the provision of these services does not impact funds allocated for patient care.

Request 2:

For the financial year 2024/25, income from patient and visitor car parking charges was £2,178,914.

The income generated from car parking contributes towards the cost of providing and maintaining car parking facilities and the provision of these services does not impact funds allocated for patient care.

Request 3:

The Trust does not issue parking charge notices (PCNs). The penalty notice system is operated by UK Parking Control Ltd (UKPC) as an independent operator, and therefore the Trust does not hold information on the number of PCNs issued to staff or the revenue generated from those PCNs. UKPC retain 100% of revenue from fines issued.

Request 4:

The Trust does not issue parking charge notices (PCNs).
