Introduction

This is the first combined Mersey and West Lancashire (MWL) combined patient profile report, that looks at the demographics of the patients who accessed inpatient and outpatient services across all sites (Whiston, St Helens, Newton, Southport and Ormskirk) during the 12 month period from 1st January 2024 to 31st December 2024.

Attached as appendices are the individual reports for the sites that were previously St Helens and Knowsley (Appendix C) as well as Southport and Ormskirk (Appendix F) in order to compare the demographics to the previous years.
